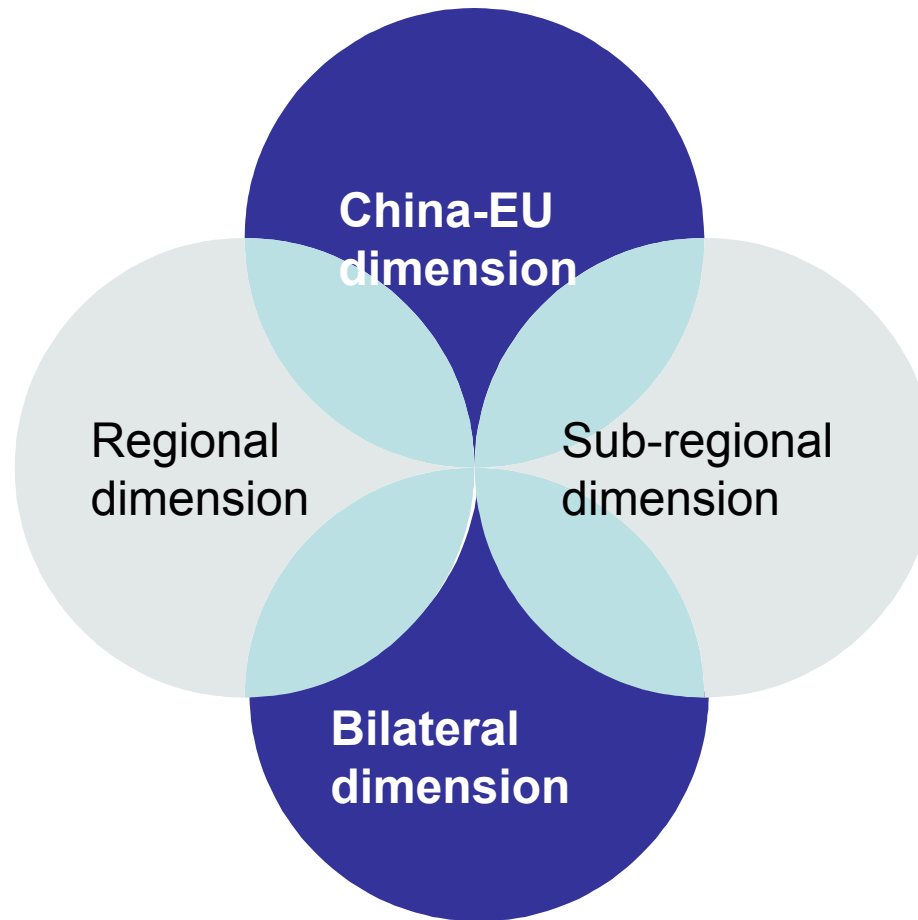

The Belgrade Guideline

China-CEEC cooperation is in line with China-EU relations... to deepening their partnership for peace, growth, reform and civilization based on the principles of equality, respect and trust, thus contributing as appropriate to the implementation of the EU-China 2020 Strategic Agenda for Cooperation.

1. The China-CEEC relationship is part of the China-EU relationship.
2. It can enrich and promote China-EU relationship.
3. EU-China 2020 Strategic Agenda for Cooperation is the guideline of China-EU cooperation. It also helps the middle-term plan of China-CEEC cooperation, which will be created in 2015.

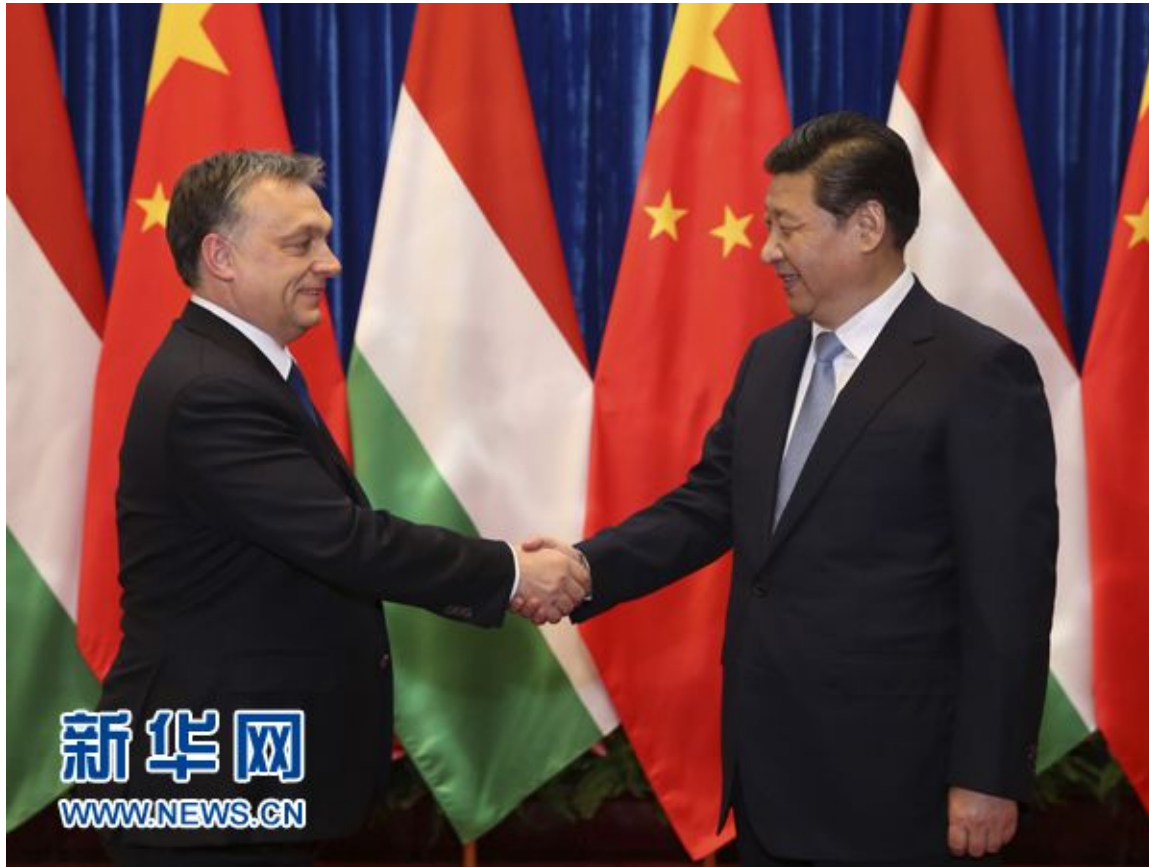
